Re: Financial Regulation Proposals

Dear Mr. Chairman:

I am writing to you on behalf of the Council of Institutional Investors (“Council”). The Council is a nonprofit association of public, union, and corporate pension funds with combined assets that exceed \$3 trillion.

Member funds are major long-term shareowners with a duty to protect the retirement assets of millions of American workers. The Council strives to educate its members and the public about good corporate governance, shareowner rights and related investment issues, and to advocate on our members’ behalf.

Consistent with the Council’s mission to educate our members and the public, we recently issued the attached white paper, *Some Investor Perspectives on Financial Regulation Proposals*. The white paper, authored by Professor Lawrence A. Cunningham of George Washington University, examines—from the viewpoint of investors—concepts such as mutual recognition in securities regulation, integrating securities and futures regulation, and single-agency oversight of all financial markets.

We are hopeful that the white paper will contribute constructively to the ongoing discussion about financial regulatory reform. As you and your colleagues debate how to modernize and improve our financial regulatory system, we would respectfully request that the white paper and other investor perspectives be a critical part of the conversation.
