

In 2021, Tracy Stewart joined the Council of Institutional Investors as Director of Research. From 2014 to 2021, Tracy worked at Florida SBA, the fourth largest public pension fund in the U.S., where her responsibilities included developing corporate governance policy and research, as well as conducting company engagements and proxy voting for the SBA's \$200 billion in assets under management. She had previously performed similar duties for Florida SBA from 2005 to 2010. Tracy served as a visiting assistant professor in finance at Florida State University from 2011 to 2013. From 2010 to 2011, Tracy served as executive director of the Shareowner Education Network, a 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation devoted to promoting greater exercise of investor rights and responsibilities. From 1997 to 2000, she was a chemical engineer in the petroleum cracking catalysts division of Engelhard Corporation (since merged with BASF).

Tracy received a Master in Business Administration degree and completed three years of graduate coursework in the finance doctoral program at Florida State University. She holds a Bachelor of Science degree in chemical engineering from Florida State University. She has also earned the Chartered Financial Analyst (CFA) and CIPM designations.
